Dear Hiring Team,

Watercare's graduate programme is the kind of structured, systems-level environment where a mechanical engineering background translates directly into useful work, and I would like to be considered for the Graduate Engineer role.

My experience has centred on making technical systems more reliable and easier to operate. At Meridian Motion Labs, I refreshed a field enclosure design around pilot-build feedback, raising first-pass assembly completion from 84 to 95 percent. At Northforge Instruments, I built and released a service fixture that reduced repair setup time by 27 percent, supported by clear technician documentation. Both projects required working across manufacturing, quality, and operations teams to turn findings into controlled, usable outcomes.

Water infrastructure is new territory for me, and that is part of the appeal. The rotational structure suits how I work best: learning a system thoroughly before drawing conclusions, and producing documentation that helps the next person work faster.
